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Spotlight on Enrollment

Recent downward trends in total public school enrollment are expected to continue for at least a few more years. The chart below shows the composition of this decline by student eligibility for free or reduced lunch. The number of students eligible for reduced lunch has been relatively stable for the last four years. College/Postsecondary Enrollment and Progress

Recent data provides the most comprehensive data about college going, persistence, and graduation that is currently available for Connecticut's public high schools. They were created for the Connecticut State Department of Education by students who graduated from Connecticut Public High Schools in 2005-2007 through 2013-14 and subsequently enrolled in postsecondary institutions (voluntarily at any point between June 2007 and June 2014).

Spotlight on Postsecondary Enrollment and Progress

Below is a selection from the Enrollment, Retention, and Graduation: Statewide Results.


Among students in the 2013 public high school graduating class, 73.3 percent enrolled in college at any time during their first year after graduation. Nearly 47 percent of the high school graduating class of 2003 enrolled in college within four years of graduation.
