

Educator Attrition Report Notes

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Overview

The Educator Attrition report provides turnover data for Connecticut public school teachers and certified educators. Annual data are reported at the state, district, and school levels from 2018-19 to the present.

Teacher Turnover is defined as the percent of certified teachers who were teaching in year X but were not teaching in year X+1.

Educator Turnover is defined as the percent of certified teachers who were staffed in a certified educator position in year X but were not staffed in a certified educator position in year X+1.

All data are as of October 1. So, the 2023-24 teacher turnover rate is the percent of certified teachers who were teaching on October 1, 2023 but were not teaching on October 1, 2024.

All counts and percentages are reported by educator, not by full-time equivalent (FTE) units.

How to Use this Report

The default view presents the most recent statewide data in the Classroom Teachers Dashboard, which includes bar charts that summarize turnover data by year and provides a breakdown of the percentage of teachers who stayed and left the classroom. Users can select different school years, and can also change from the state view to see summary charts by district type or by district.

The second tab of the report is Classroom Teachers Data, which allows users to view a list table of the turnover data since 2018-19. Filters include: Level (State/District/School); School Year; Turnover (Yes/No); Turnover Description; District; School/Program; Organization Type; Support Designation; Low Grade; and High Grade.

In the Classroom Teachers Data tab, the following turnover designations are included:

All data are as of October 1.
