# Per Pupil Expenditures By Object (School)-Report Notes

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#### Overview

This report details the school-level expenditures by object, and provides limited demographic information for each school. The object describes the service or commodity obtained as the result of a specific expenditure. Dollar amounts are rounded to the nearest whole dollar. Amounts may not sum exactly due to rounding.

#### **How to Use this Report**

Use the dropdowns to generate results for this report. Export the results to a .csv file by clicking **Export .csv file**.

- To view School PPE by Object for all districts and all schools, select "All Districts" from the District dropdown, and the Schools dropdown will default to "All Schools." Click Submit.
- To view School PPE by Object for a single district and all schools in that district, select the district from the District dropdown, and the Schools dropdown will default to "All Schools." Click Submit.
- To view School PPE by Object for a single district and a single school in that district, select the district from the District dropdown and the school from the Schools dropdown, and click Submit.

#### **Inclusion/Exclusion Rules**

All reports present PPE for free elementary and secondary education, including both regular and special education. Reports exclude expenditures for food services not funded by local funds, debt, capital, adult education, community services, and state contributions to teachers' retirement. Data for the following cases are not listed separately; however, their amounts are included in applicable totals:

- Schools or outplaced tuition types with low pupil counts (5 or less)
- Programs operated by school districts, but not classified as schools
- For years earlier than 2019-20, magnet schools that enroll both full-time and parttime students
