This report provides the percentages of school district expenditures for free elementary and secondary public education by funding source. Amounts may not sum exactly due to rounding.

How to Use this Report

- To view revenue source data for all districts, select “All Districts” from the District dropdown, and click Submit.
- To view revenue source data for a single district select the district from the District dropdown, and click Submit.

Inclusion/Exclusion Rules

For 2016-17 and earlier, this report provides the option to include or exclude school construction revenues. For 2017-18 and later, only reports excluding school construction revenues are available.

Local	Revenue from property taxes and other local sources.	The percentage (and amount for 2017-18 and later) of school district revenue from local funds.
State	Revenue from state sources, including Education Cost Sharing as well as grants for specific purposes such as magnet schools, charter schools, bilingual programs and agricultural science and technology centers.	The percentage (and amount for 2017-18 and later) of school district revenue from state funds.
Federal	Revenue from federal sources, including Titles I, II, III and IV, and other federal grants.	The percentage (and amount for 2017-18 and later) of school district revenue from federal funds.
Tuition and Other	Revenue from other sources, including tuition received, contributions, and fees.	The percentage (and amount for 2017-18 and later) of school district revenue from tuition and other funds.

Source(s) and Update Schedule

Fund sources are based on CSDE grant payment records, and financial data reported by local and regional school districts and charter schools on Forms ED001/ED001C for 2016-17 and earlier years, and financial data reported by local and regional school districts, regional education service centers, and charter schools in the Education Financial System (EFS) for 2017-18 and later years, and for the Connecticut Technical Education and Career System (CTECS) in the EFS for 2022-23 and later years.

For local and regional school districts, the portion of municipal budget appropriations to the school district funded by state grants paid to their town(s) such as the Education Cost Sharing Grant are included as state funds on this report.

Tuition amounts received are included in the Tuition and Other category whether received from local or other sources.

The data have not been fully audited; audits may result in changes in the data presented.
