How to Use this Report

You can view trend data (last five years) or single year data using the year dropdown on the default report. The listing and comparison radio buttons at the top of the report allow you to navigate between two forms of this report. The listing report displays counts for the state, all districts or a single district, all schools or a single school, and all race/ethnic categories or a single race/ethnic category. The comparison report allows you to select more specific criteria including non-consecutive or more than five years and/or a subset of districts, schools or race/ethnic categories. Click *Submit* to render results.
