



What is the Seal of Biliteracy?

- Recognizes high school graduate who have attained a level of proficiency in English and at least one other language
- Encourages students to develop and sustain home and heritage languages and/or to study languages
- Provides employers with a method of identifying CT graduates with biliteracy skills
- Celebrates students' linguistic and cultural knowledge



Who qualifies for the Seal of Biliteracy?

 All students are eligible to receive the Seal of Biliteracy based on evidence of achieving the designated level of language proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation.

To be eligible to earn the Seal, a student must:

- Complete all English language arts requirements for graduation
- Demonstrate proficiency equivalent to Intermediate Mid on ACTFL Proficiency Guidelines in another language in grades 10, 11, or 12

TCS data collection and SAM


- Districts report seal-eligible test results in the Student Achievement Module (SAM) which is housed in the Teacher-Course-Student (TCS) application.
- Data collection completes in August after the tested year
 - Data for 2021-22 were collected in August 2022
- The Seal of Biliteracy report currently includes one year of data
- All 10th, 11th and 12th grade **June PSIS** students are included in the report.

- A student has Access if they take a language test.
- **75**% or **3** of **4** students had **access** to a language test.

- A student demonstrated achievement if they passed a language test.
- 50% or 2 of 4 students passed a language test.








View applied filters and reset report to default state

Student Access and Achievement by Language

If a student accessed more than one language/test, they are counted once for each language/test. Students are only counted once in the denominator used to calculate the percentages.

Test pass rate



- The test pass rate is the total number of passing scores out of tests attempted
- 60% or 3 of 5 tests had passing scores

French: 50% pass rate - Italian: 50% pass rate - Spanish: 100% pass rate












How do I export data?


Two easy options:

 Right-click on the table, graph, or analytics object from which you want to export data and select Export data... from the shortcut menu; or




2. Click on the table, graph, or analytics object from which you want to export data, then click the "snowman" (i.e., vertical ellipsis or icon) on the table, graph, or object and select Export data... from the shortcut menu.


